Jann T. Balmer RN PhD serves as the Director for Continuing Medical Education for the University of Virginia's School of Medicine. She is also President of the Alliance for Continuing Medical Education (Alliance). Dr. Balmer has served on the Alliance Board of Directors for 4 years.

Dr. Balmer has been an active volunteer for the Accreditation Council for Continuing Medical Education from 1992-2005, serving on the Accreditation Review Committee from 1994-2000, as vice chair in 1998, and as chair in 1999 and 2000. She has also served as the Editor of the Alliance publication: "Best Practices in Accreditation Handbook." For her exemplary and long-term service, she received the 2003 Willard M. Duff, PhD Award and the 2007 Robert Raszowski MD PhD ACCME Hero Award.

She previously served as Nurse Clinician, Division of Pediatric Cardiology, University of Virginia Department of Pediatrics (1985-90); Staff Nurse, Pediatric Unit, University of Virginia Medical Center (1984-85); and Assistant Professor of the Nursing Undergraduate Program at the University of Pittsburgh School of Nursing (1980-83).

Dr. Balmer holds a Bachelor of Science degree in nursing from the University of Pittsburgh, Master of Science in child health nursing from the State University of New York at Buffalo, and a Ph.D. in higher education administration from the University of Pittsburgh.
